At the June 13, 2017 Conservation Board meeting, concerns were expressed regarding the subject property and its location within certain overlay districts in the Town. The three overlay districts are the Scenic Protection Overlay District, Scenic Ridgeline Overlay, and the Open Space Conservation Overlay District.

Attached are the three maps that make up the Town of Philipstown Resource Protection Overlay District Zoning Map. Each map identifies the subject property and shows its relation to each district. As shown on the Scenic Protection Overlay District map, the property does not lie within the district, but the southwest corner of the property abuts it. The second sheet is the Scenic Ridgelines map, and depicts scenic ridgelines within the Town. As shown on the map, the subject property does not contain any scenic ridgelines. The last map depicts the Open Space Conservation Overlay District with the project site identified. As shown, the site does not lie within the Open Space overlay.
