

Public Hearing – Continental Village Park & Water Districts
November 8, 2017

The Town Board held a Public Hearing on the above date at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Hall, 238 Main Street, Cold Spring, New York. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear comments for/against the Proposed 2018 Budget for the Continental Village Park District and the Continental Village Water District.

Town Clerk Merando read the Public Notice.

Michael Phelan, Superintendent of the Continental Village Park District submitted the written breakdown for the three towns total share distribution, which is essentially the same as last year. He noted that the biggest expense this year is the Dam Expenses/Rehabilitation. He explained that the debt service for the Dam will be converted to a Statutory Installment Bond. New York State gave the town 650,000 for the rehabilitation of the dam, which was nearly 80% of the funds needed. There was discussion with regard to the dam, inspections and some possible funding in the future.

Ralph Bassignani, Superintendent of the Continental Village Water District report that personnel services decreased for 2018 as Edward Barticcio to has retired. An increase of 10,000 is for the anticipated water rates due to the NYC aqueduct shutdowns. Contractual line has been decreased by 1,800 due to lower insurance cost.

There being no further comments from the public, Councilman Van Tassel made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman Montgomery to close the Public Hearing at 7:45 p.m.
