Dear Honorable Supervisor and Town Board Members:

On March 30 the Town received two (2) bids for the replacement of the Winston Lane culvert, as follows:

Company	Total Bid Amount
Ben Cozzi, Inc d/b/a Northern Construction 1992 Commerce Street Yorktown Heights, NY 10598	\$260,825.00
Ben Ciccone, Inc. 151 Daley Road Poughkeepsie, NY 12603	\$348,575.00

As noted above, the apparent low bidder was Northern Construction of Yorktown Heights, NY. Further, the low bid is well within the estimated project amount of the FEMA Project Worksheet (PW) developed for the work, which will form the basis for the Federal reimbursements to be obtained.

Northern Construction has submitted a bid bond in the amount of \$22,000, which is in excess of the 5% requirement contained in the Bid Documents, to serve as a bid security. We have reviewed representative references given by the Low Bidder. This includes various projects completed by Donald Flood of Kect Construction, who Mr. Cozzi has identified as one who will work directly for Northern Construction in the performance of this project, and whose experience includes various culvert replacement projects for the Town of Amenia in Dutchess County. The Amenia Highway Superintendent spoke highly of Flood's qualifications and experience, and therefore we consider the low bidder to be qualified to provide the services which the Town of Philipstown is seeking to accomplish.

Therefore, provided that the Town Attorney finds the bid form, bid bond, and non-collusive bidding certificate to be satisfactory, we believe that Northern Construction's bid proposal in the total amount of \$260,000.00, may be accepted.

If the Town approves a resolution to award Northern Construction the project, then a formal "Notice of Award" should be issued. The "Notice of Award" should include a reminder that, as required in the Instructions to Bidders, the Performance Bond and the Payment Bond must be provided within 10 days from the notification of award or when the agreement is executed, whichever is sooner. The bidder should supply the required insurance certificate in the same time frame.

Lastly, the Bid Bonds for both bidders should be retained until a contract is executed with Northern Construction. Upon their submittal of acceptable bonds and insurances, and execution of an Agreement, you may then release these Bid Bonds.


