Dear Mr. Chirico:

As we have previously discussed, Ben Cozzi, Inc, d/b/a Northern Construction (Contractor for this project), encountered differing conditions from that estimated on the Bid Form. He is therefore seeking additional monies for higher volumes of rock removal which was required in order to construct the temporary diversion swale that was required in order to construct the new culvert. Further, additional quantities of Item 4 materials were required as part of the roadway construction, and for backfilling the diversion swale upon completion of the new culvert installation.

In my review of this request, and subsequent negotiations with the Contractor, I consider the following additional costs to be justified:

- Rock Removal
 Original Bid Quantity = 100 cy; Actual quantity removed = 135 cy
 Additional cost = 35 cy x \$120/cy (Bid Item) = \$4,200.00
- Furnish and place Item 4 materials
 The Contractor requested an additional 315 cy; both parties have agreed on 200 cy
 Contractor's original request = \$7,800 for 315 cy
 Agreed upon "extra" amount = \$4952.38

On this basis, we have attached Change Order No. 1 in the total amount of \$9,152.38 which we recommend be approved by the Town. The total original Contract Price was \$260,825.00. Upon authorization of this Change Order, the total Contract Cost will increase to \$269,977.38. This should be processed through the Town Board for formal approval.

As you are aware, at this time the project culvert and roadway is now in place and open to traffic. Only minor items of work remain to be completed to close out the project. If you have any questions, please contact us at your earliest convenience.


