TOWN LANDFILL

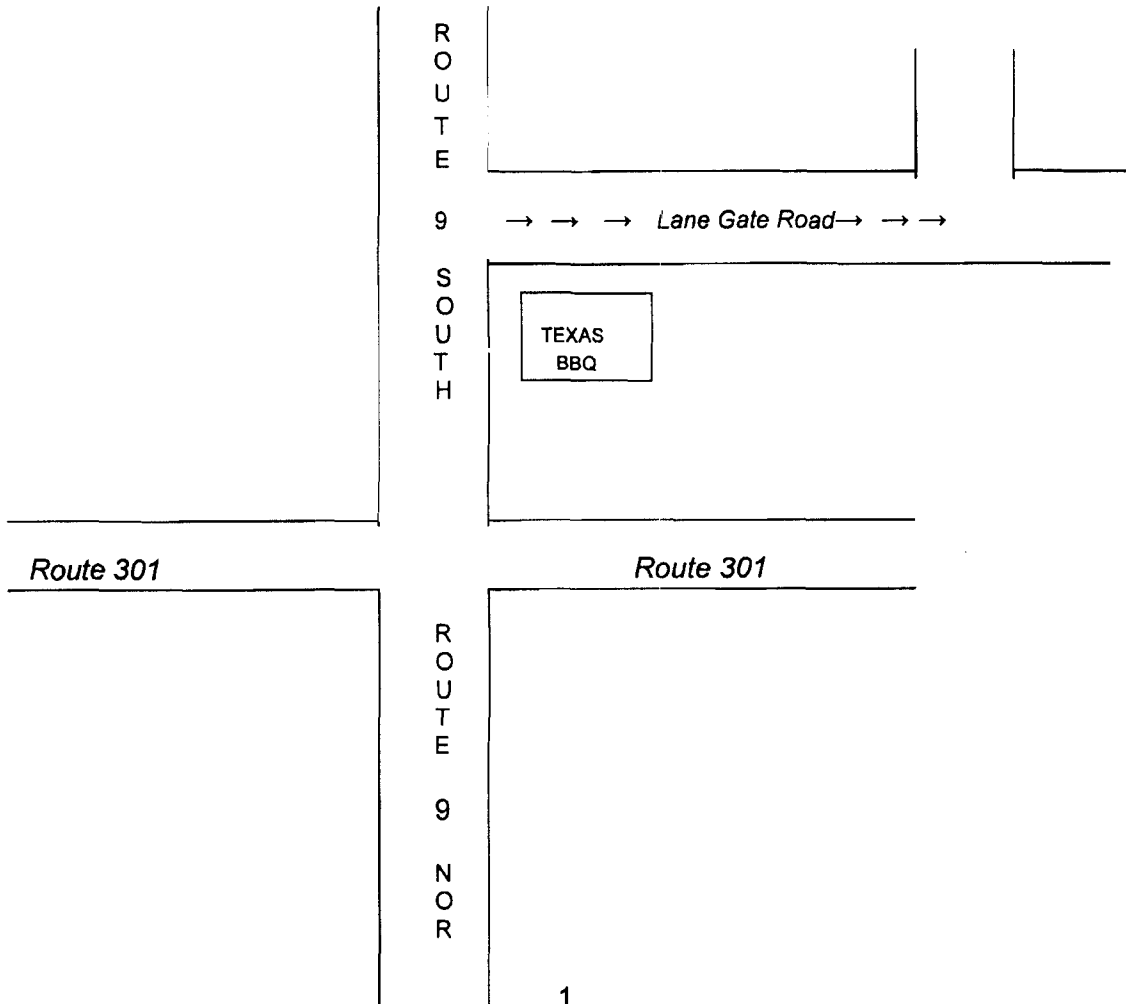
The Town Landfill is open for recycling every Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Plastic, glass, electronics, metal, cardboard and paper products are accepted. Paper and cardboard must be tied in bundles. No Paper will be accepted if it is loose or in plastic bags.

All metal items require a pass from the Town Clerk's Office. As always, recyclables are FREE.

FEES: **\$2.00 car per trip**
 \$5.00 truck per trip

TOWN OF PHILIPSTOWN RECYCLING PROGRAM

Items accepted:

- *Paper and cardboard products*
- *All electronics*
- *White goods*
- *Metals.*

Paper and cardboard products must be bundled with all insides (foil, wax paper, etc.) removed. Do not use plastic bags.

No permit is required for recyclables and electronics.

A permit is required for metal products and white goods (i.e. washing machines, scrap metal, refrigerators (no Freon, doors removed), air conditioners (Freon removed)).

Permits available at the Town Hall, 238 Main Street, Cold Spring during regular business hours Mon. - Fri. 8:30 am to 4:00 pm.

Fees are as follows:

\$2.00 for a car load

\$5.00 for truck load

TOWN OF PHILIPSTOWN RECYCLING PROGRAM

Items NOT accepted:

- Furniture, mattresses
- Any wood products, wood and/or bags of brush
- Ballasts
- Capacitors
- Freon containing items – air conditioners, refrigerators, etc
- Gas cylinders
- Light bulbs
- Liquids – items containing liquids
- Household batteries – AA, AAA, D, C
- Lithium batteries
- Medical equipment (any material that is considered or has come in contact with biohazard or radioactive materials)
- VHS cassette tapes
- Propane or BBQ propane tanks
